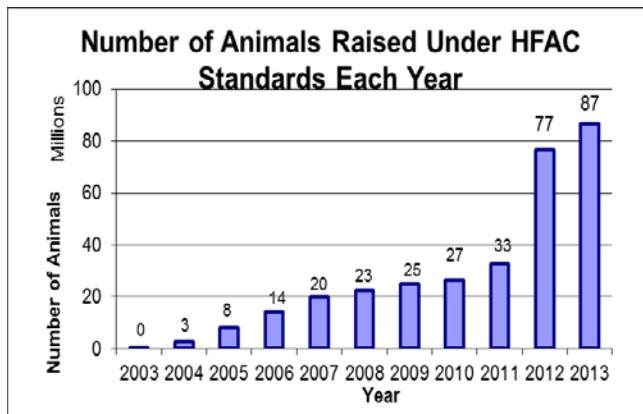


GROWTH

This year, 86.8 million farm animals were raised under HFAC's standards. This increase of 10 million farm animals raised under our standards and inspected to ensure that all of our standards meeting on farm through slaughter has been possible because of our donors and volunteers. 86.8 million farm animals' lives have benefited from the Certified Humane® program. In addition, consumers have benefitted from not consuming unnecessary antibiotics and animal byproducts. Farmers have also benefitted by being supported and recognized for their superior farming practices.



There are now 111 companies, representing 4,900 farms that are Certified Humane®. These farms and ranches are located in 45 States in the US and 4 Canadian Provinces as well as in Brazil and Peru. 17 new companies were Certified Humane® in 2013.

Certified Humane® products can be found in over 13,394 supermarkets in all 50 states and across Canada. That is 6,394 more stores this year than last year!



Humane Farm Animal is Now Endorsed or Supported by 67 Humane Organizations

National, regional, and local humane organizations have memberships of their own and communicate with their members through media such as their newsletters and websites. Through their support, they let their members know about the Certified Humane® program. These humane organizations help further our message through outreach to their millions of supporters.

Sobeys Became the First North American Grocery Retailer to Offer Certified Humane® Beef, Poultry and Pork products.

Sobeys is one of two national supermarket retailers in Canada and now requires that all of the pork, beef and chicken for their national "Better Food For All" program must be Certified Humane®. This came about because of collaboration between Sobeys and **Chef Jamie Oliver**.

Chef Jamie Oliver recommended the Certified Humane® program to Sobeys after his team visited many farms and ranches on the Certified Humane® program in the US and Canada. You can
