



FEE SCHEDULE 2026 – CERTIFIED HUMANE ASIA (CHA)

APPLICATION FEE

CHA charges an Application Fee for operations submitting an application for Initial Certification or Certification Renewal in order to cover administrative costs associated with processing the application. The application fees are as follows:

Date application submitted	Fee
For new clients or renewals confirmed until 60 days before the anniversary of the last annual inspection	US\$ 100
For renewals confirmed between 60 and 30 days before the anniversary of the last annual inspection	US\$ 200
For renewals confirmed in less than 30 days before the anniversary of the last annual inspection	US\$ 400

INSPECTION FEES

Calculated based on time dedicated to the complete annual inspection visit. For additional audits (including unannounced ones), there is a 30% discount. Inspection fees do not include logistic costs (transportation/food/accommodation).

Farm Inspections: CHA fee for conducting inspections of a farm is **US\$800/day(8hs)/inspector** for Japan, South Korea and Singapore; **US\$675** for Thailand, Malaysia, Vietnam, Philippines, Maldives, Sri Lanka, Turkey and Jordan; **US\$575** for Indonesia, Laos, Cambodia and Myanmar; and **US\$450** for India, Bangladesh, Nepal and Pakistan.

Processor, Product Manufacturing Operations (PMO), Pooled Product Operators (PPO), Slaughter and Handling Facility: CHA fee for conducting inspections of a PMO, PPO, Processor, Sales Office, Restaurant or Slaughter is **US\$800/day(8hs)/facility/inspector**. For shorter duration inspections (<8 hs), there is no reduction on the above-mentioned amount.

CERTIFICATION FEES

CHA certification fees are **payable on ALL products that are licensed for sale as Certified Humane®** by a certified producer or farm. Therefore, monthly fees (based on the following chart) should be calculated and on all licensed products, regardless of the type of labeling used.

Certified operations must pay certification fees to CHA on a quarterly basis. At the discretion of the Executive Director, operations may pre-arrange semester or annual payments. Product Manufacturing Operations (PMOs) do not pay certification fees.
